
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable. Localised accumulations of windslab will develop on North through East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Corrie rims and gully tops will be mainly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong to gale force Westerly winds with snow showers overnight above 700 metres, these becoming much lighter during the morning before dying out in the afternoon. The 800 to 900 metre freezing level will rise towards summit levels by the end of the day.
