

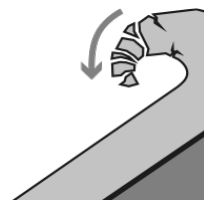

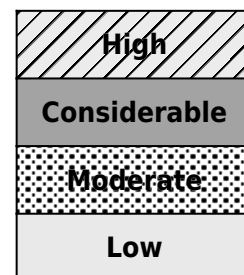
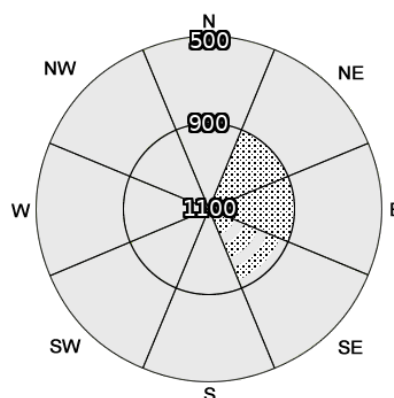
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Marginally stabilised windslab will develop and gain depth on very steep and sheltered North-East to South-East aspects above 900m. New cornice development expected over steepest lee slopes. Exposed and heavily scoured areas of the old snowpack will remain well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavier snow showers for a time overnight becoming lighter and scattered during the day. Strong Westerly or West-North-Westerly winds. Cold but temperatures easing a little as the day progresses.

Comments

Blustery snow showers but very little new wind-blown snow accumulations on Monday.
