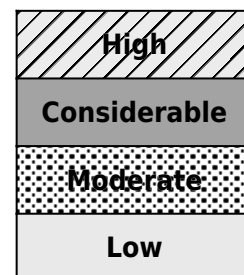
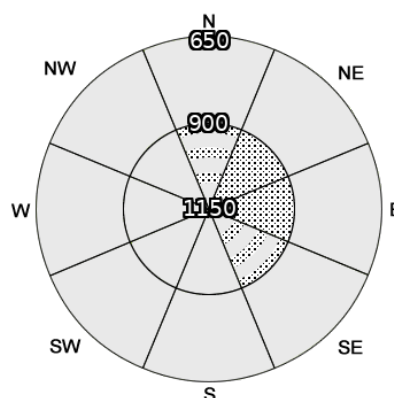
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations will continue to develop in sheltered locations on some North but mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Where accumulations achieve depth on steep terrain such as gully exits they will only be moderately bonded. Elsewhere snow cover will be thin on most of the ground with older patchy snow remaining very firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight there will be a brief spell of rain before turning to snow at all levels. Gale force winds will be from the West-North-West throughout the day.
