#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 11/01/2017


##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will freeze and become stable as the temperature drops overnight. Localised areas of fresh windslab will be deposited with greatest accumulations in sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-West wind veering West overnight and becoming very strong. Showers, falling as rain at all levels initially, turning to snow to progressively lower levels. Freezing level, starting above the summits, will drop rapidly overnight and be around 500 metres during the day.

##### Comments

Wintery weather for the next few days.
