




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initial stabilisation of the existing snowpack then new snow instability expected on steep and very sheltered lee slopes. Most affected areas will be East-facing locations above 850m, with localised instability on North-East and South-East aspects. New cornice development expected over coire backwalls and gullies of the same aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Damp mild conditions will be displaced overnight by much colder, wintry weather. Snow showers from the early hours carried on very strong Westerly or West-North-Westerly winds.
