

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Areas especially affected will be in steeper sheltered terrain such as, corrie rims, gully tops and crag aprons. More localised windslab will form on other aspects due to cross loading. Fragile cornices will develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers continuing at all levels on strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will fall to 300 metres.
