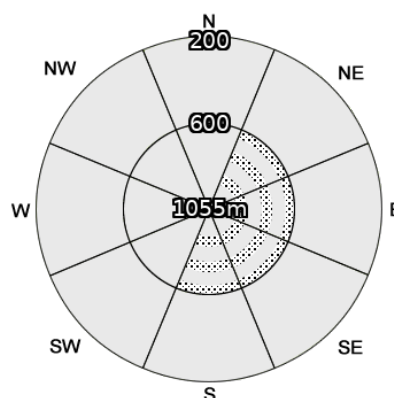

Avalanche Problems

Wind Slab

Persistent Weak Layers
Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited with greatest accumulations in sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects above 600 metres. Southerly aspects will also be affected in the afternoon. The limited old snowpack will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.


Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong Westerly wind easing slightly by dawn, then veering North-West in the afternoon. Snow showers throughout. Freezing level around 300 metres.

Comments

Less fresh snow than forecast today, mainly falling as graupel.
