




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will continue to develop affecting mostly East to South aspects above 800 metres. Localised windslab will form on other aspects due to cross loading. More localised moderately bonded windslab on these aspects below 800 metres. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight heavy snow showers above 200 metres dying out by mid morning, mostly dry through the afternoon. Strong to gale force North-Westerly winds easing slightly through the day. The 400 metres freezing level will fall to 200 metres.

Continuing very cold through Friday possibly milder at the weekend.
