

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Soft, moderate to weakly bonded windslab will continue to build in high, sheltered lee locations. The most affected areas will be North-East to South-East facing locations above 800m. There will be some cross loading onto steepest gully flanks and exits of other aspects. Weak cornices will build over coire backwalls of these same aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



##### Forecast Weather Influences

The cold showery North Westerly airflow will continue to affect the area, this will bring further snow showers to all levels. Winds, initially strong overnight will again ease during the day as the showers die out.

##### Comments

Skis useful for access; drifted deposits lying at low elevations on tracks. Many areas are scoured at higher levels.
