



Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further unstable windslab will be deposited. Greatest accumulations will be in sheltered locations on North-East through East to South aspects above 600 metres. Gullies and crag aprons will be particularly affected. Other aspects will be scoured with minimal snow cover. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong North-North-West winds overnight easing through the day. A period of heavy snow overnight followed by occasional showers. Freezing level around 300 metres.

Comments

A thin cover everywhere with deeper drifts in places.
