

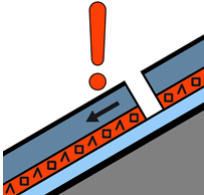

Avalanche Problems



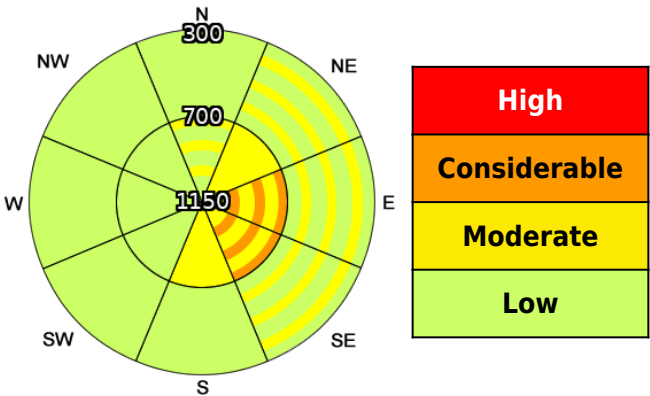
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some further deposition of windslab will occur. Areas of unstable windslab will exist in sheltered locations, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 700 meters. Although not extensive, these areas will be poorly bonded. Other aspects will be scoured and will hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will generally become lighter through the period. Westerly winds will ease. The freezing level will be around 400 metres for most of the period, rising in the afternoon.

Comments

Reasonable mountain conditions expected on Saturday, turning mild after that.
