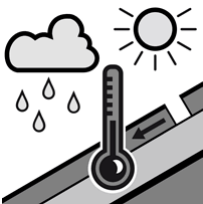

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 15/01/2017

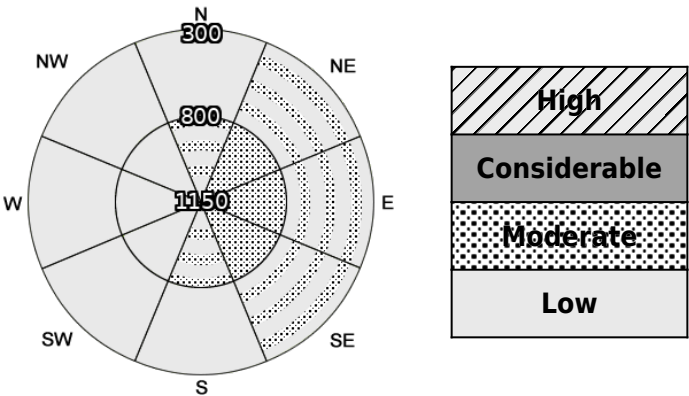
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of instability overnight as the snowpack becomes saturated. Through the day it will continue to thaw and will very slowly consolidate. Instabilities will remain in the windslab which exists in mainly sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 meters. These areas are not particularly extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A significant change is expected. After some snow early in the night, the freezing level will rise well above the summits where it will remain through the day. Heavy rain in the later part of the the night will be followed by light and patchy rain through the day.
