




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in all locations. Some instabilities will be maintained in steep and convex areas on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain and drizzle will continue into the night before clearing during the early morning. Mainly dry through the day with hill fog. Winds will be moderate West-South-Westerly. The freezing level will remain well above the summits.
