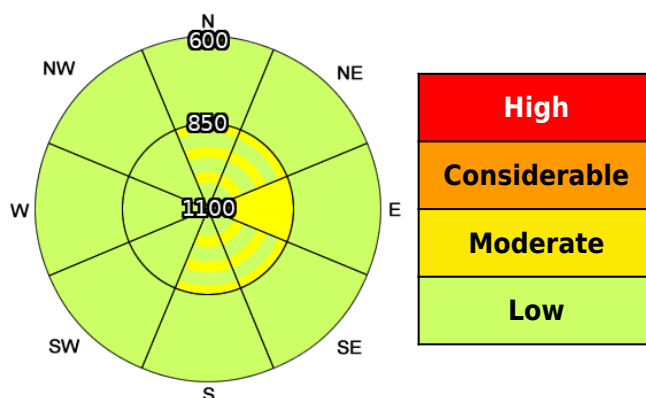
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Thaw conditions. Only wet patches of snow remain below 600m. Above this the now much depleted snowpack will continue to consolidate as a steady thaw continues. Some localised wet snow instabilities and drooping cornices will persist at highest elevations, with fluctuating temperatures to below summits some improvement is expected in these accumulations on steepest North-East to South-East aspects above 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

The thaw conditions will persist with freezing levels remaining well above the summits, apart from a brief dip below at first light. Some overnight light rain will die away to give a dry day. The winds will be light to moderate West-South-West, then South-Westerly.
