



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 17/01/2017**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The diminishing and moist snowpack will thaw at all levels and continue to consolidate and remain stable throughout. The most extensive areas of snow are on steep locations, East to South aspects and mainly above 700 metres. Many areas will be bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be outbreaks of mainly light rain and drizzle accompanied by extensive hill fog at times. Mild and fresh South-West wind with the freezing level well above the summits.

**Comments**

Spring-like conditions on the mountains. Good walking with most hill paths clear of snow. Many hillsides are bare of snow. Mild weather set to continue.
