



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 17/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The depleted snowpack although moist will continue to consolidate in the steady thaw conditions. The stability of the remaining accumulations on steepest North-East to South-East aspects above 850m will continue to improve as daytime freezing levels lower to below summits. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Settled and mild conditions with a continuing general thaw. The freezing levels will remain above the summits overnight, lowering to around 750m during the day. Very early patchy light rain, drizzle will die away to give a dry day. The winds will be fresh to moderate South Westerly.
