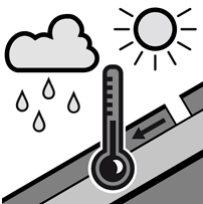


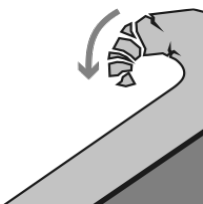

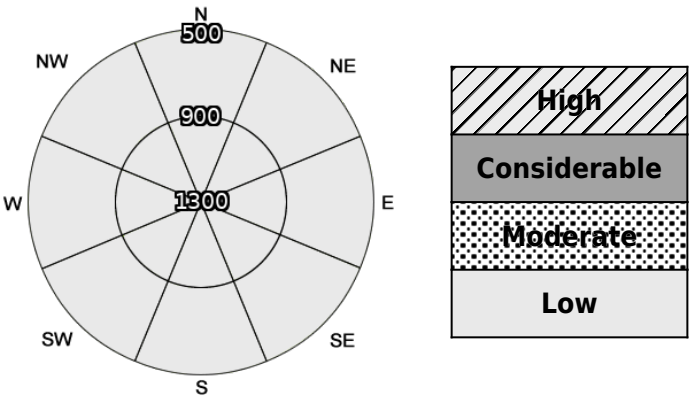

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in all locations. Greatest accumulations will remain on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. The snowpack will be generally well bonded with surface instabilities possible on some very steep slopes. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above summit levels as mild dry conditions continue with hill fog. Moderate South-Westerly winds will gradually strengthen through the day.
