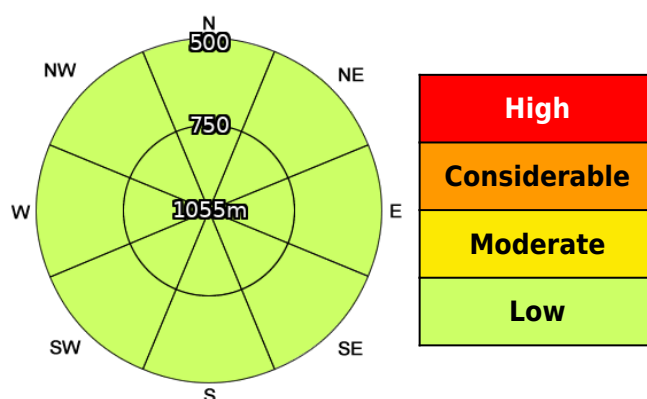


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 21/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The depleted snowpack will remain very patchy and stable and continue to consolidate. The snow will be generally soft, but much firmer where it remains in the shade. The largest areas of snow will be mainly on East to South aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry, settled with long sunny periods. Moderate Southerly breeze. Inversion conditions, with perhaps some overnight frost and low lying cloud at times. The freezing level will be well above the summits.
