



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 22/01/2017**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The limited and very patchy snowpack will remain firm and stable. There will be a small chance of fresh snow on the highest summits at the end of the period, but amounts will not be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Cold and cloudy, with the freezing level dropping to 500 metres overnight. Mainly dry, perhaps a dusting of snow on the highest summits at the end of the day. Moderate Southerly wind, easing by morning, but freshening later veering South-West.

**Comments**

A colder day. The snow is generally firm throughout. High windchill in the fresh Southerly wind.
