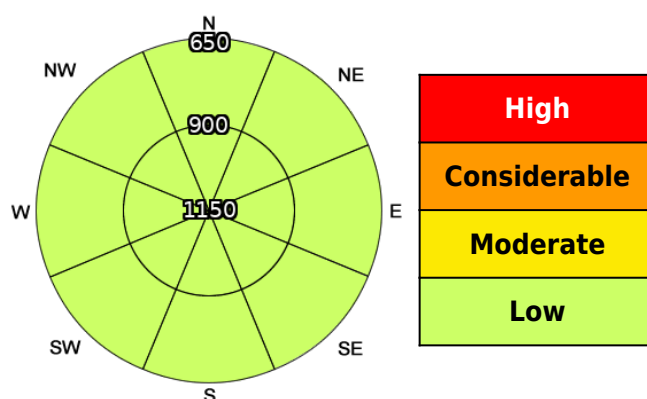


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 22/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The trace amounts of new snow will not alter the stability of the patchy snowpack which will be well bonded and stable throughout. Greatest amounts will be found on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a mainly dry but cloudy day with a trace of new snow forecast for mid-afternoon. The overnight Southerly winds will gradually veer Westerly during the day and will increase from light to moderate. It will remain cold with the freezing level around 550 metres.

Old snow patches are very firm, and icy in places.
