



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 22/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack which remains on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres will be firm well bonded and stable. Shallow and isolated accumulations of windslab will develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night with moderate to light South to South-Westerly winds. During the day occasional light snow flurries are expected on light increasing to moderate Westerly winds. The freezing level will lower to 600 metres.

Comments

The limited snow is very firm with serious run out potential on some steep slopes.
