



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 24/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The very limited and patchy snowpack will remain firm, well bonded and stable. The snow surface may soften through the day as the temperature rises. The largest patches and strips are mainly on East to South aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A period of overnight rain at all levels will ease to give a mainly dry but cloudy day. The wind will be strong and gusty at summit level, South-South-Westerly and the freezing level will be above the summits throughout the day.

Comments

Another fine and dry day. Becoming warmer over the next few days, with insignificant amounts of precipitation.
