



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The very depleted and patchy snowpack will remain firm, well bonded and stable. The largest patches and strips will be found on East to South aspects above 750 metres. The snow surface will continue to soften and the snowpack will generally moisten. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mild, cloudy and mostly dry, but with a chance of some intermittent light drizzle in the thicker cloud. The strong generally Southerly wind will gradually strengthen to become gale to severe gale force by the end of the period.

Comments

The vast majority of hillsides are bare. Severe gales are expected at summit level.
