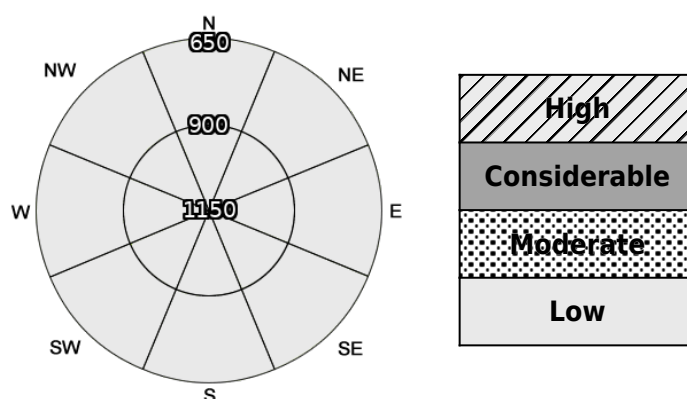


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 25/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The patchy snowpack will continue to thaw but will remain generally well bonded and stable. Cover will slowly diminish with greatest amounts being found on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight drizzle will continue into the late morning with the day remaining foggy throughout the period. Winds will be strong to gale force from the South-West. Air temperature at 900 metres will be plus 4.5 degrees centigrade overnight gradually lowering to plus 1.5 degrees by the end of the afternoon.
