

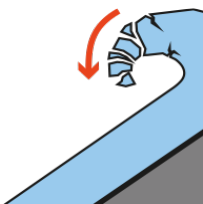

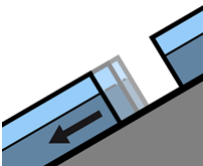

Wet Snow



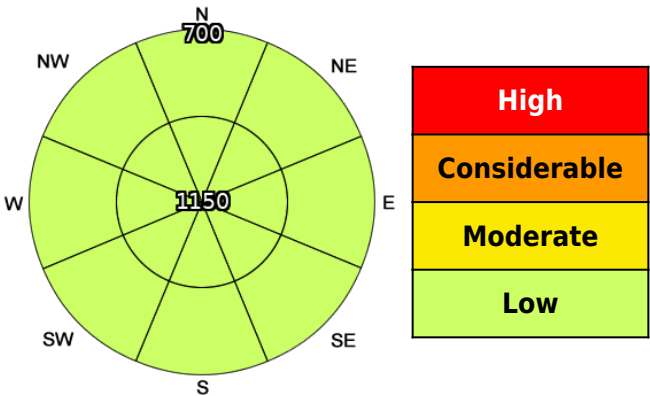
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The fragmented snowpack will remain generally well bonded in most locations with the greatest accumulations being on North to East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with the freezing level remaining well above the summits for most of the period. Freezing levels will slowly drop towards the later part of the afternoon to 800 metres. Strong to gale force winds at summit level from a Southerly direction

Comments

Forecast is for widespread gale to severe gale South to South-West winds over the summits, locally reaching storm force at times.
