

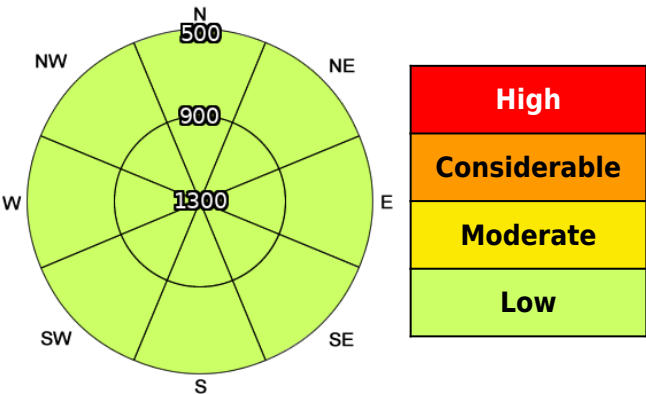

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become more moist in the milder temperatures but remain well bonded and stable in all areas with greatest accumulations remaining on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Elsewhere the ground will be mostly bare with patches of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry day with very strong sometimes storm force Southerly winds in the day. Freezing level above the summits.
