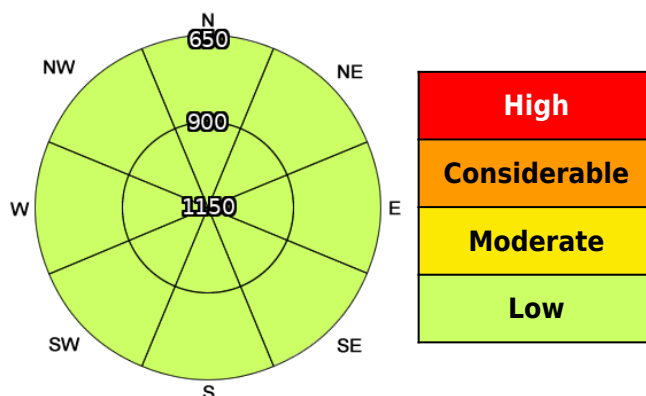

The remaining patchy snow will refreeze and become very firm and well bonded. Largest areas will be found on North-East through East to South aspects from 1000 metres. Elsewhere will be mostly free from snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry but foggy day clearing to sunshine late in the period. Strong generally Southerly winds. Inversion conditions leading to sub-zero temperatures at 900 metres from late evening onwards.
