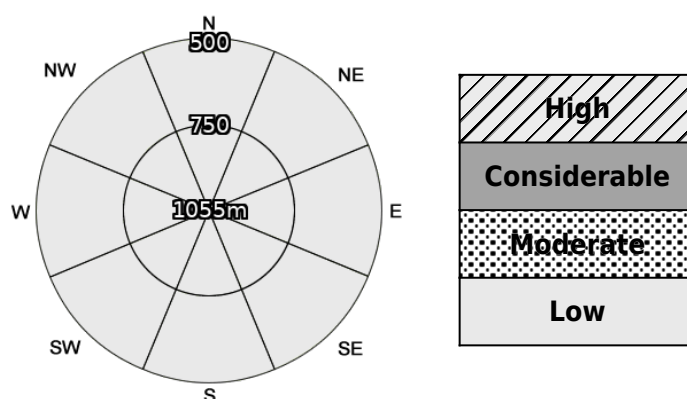


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 26/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected. The thawing and moist snowpack will be well bonded and stable and limited to isolated patches and strips of softening snow, mostly on East to South aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After some evening rain, it will be a mild, mostly dry and sunny day with the freezing level above the summits. The gale force Southerly wind will gradually ease throughout the period, backing South-South-East later.

Comments

What little remains of the snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels. Becoming colder over the next few days.
