

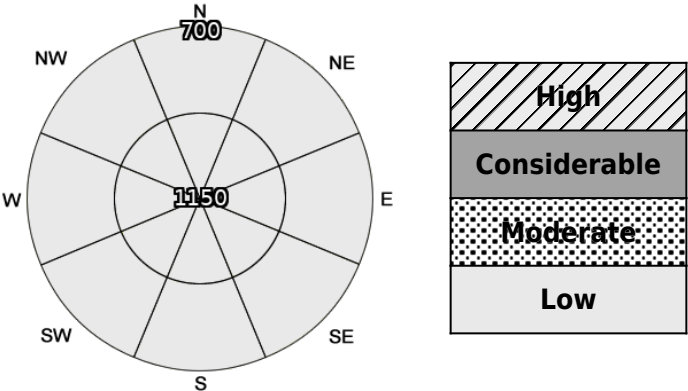

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 28/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain icy and stable. Some fresh deposits are expected on North-West through North to East aspects above 700 metres. These are expected to be limited and shallow, and will generally be avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Later in the night and through the day some showers are expected. These will fall as snow above about 500 metres. The freezing level will be around 600 metres. Moderate Southerly winds will veer to the South-West.

Comments

A little fresh snow should help to make the hills look a little more wintry at least!
