
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of fresh thin windslab will develop mainly on North and North-East aspects above 800 metres. Accumulations are expected to be small. The older snowpack will remain frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-South-East wind easing through the night and veering South-West during the day. Light snow showers from early morning onwards. Freezing level around 600 metres.
