

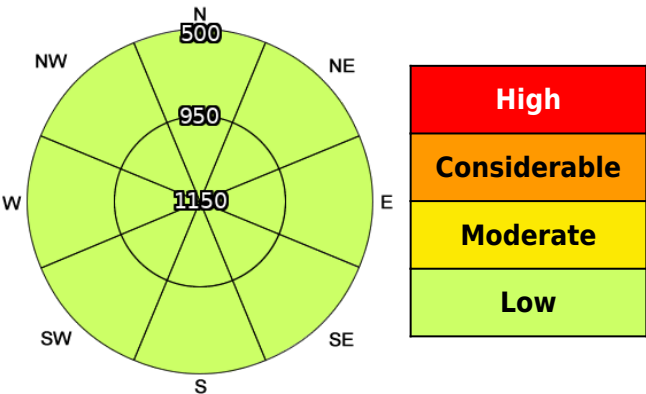

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a general light covering of new snow with some limited overnight drifting forming shallow accumulations where the new deposits overlie the refrozen snow on North-East through East to South aspects above 950 metres. These accumulations are not expected to be significant in depth and the conditions should remain generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The light snowfall will continue into the early evening, followed by a partially cloudy night and then a sunny day. Fresh overnight generally Westerly winds will decrease to light during the day. It will remain cold with the freezing level rising to 600 metres.

Comments

Very slippy conditions underfoot: Water-ice hidden by thin covering of snow.
