### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/01/2017


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack on North-East to South-East aspects will be firm and stable. Drifting snow will lead to new localised windslab developing on these aspects above 950 metres especially around corrie rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow fall will continue into the night before dying out around midnight. Dry conditions expected through the day. Moderate Westerly winds will gradually ease and back to the South-West. Freezing at around 400 metres.

#### Comments

A ridge of high pressure on Sunday, looking more unsettled and windy by Monday.
