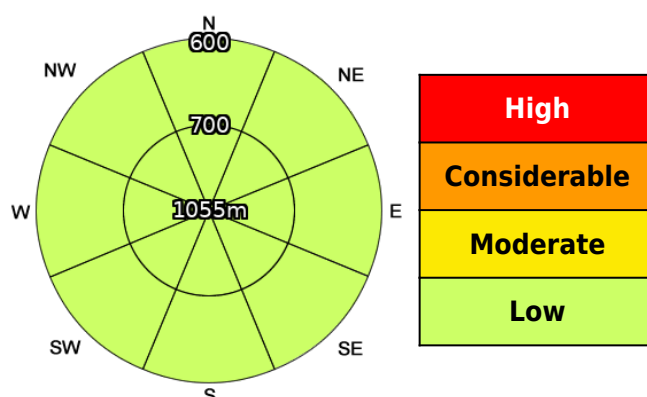


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be an insignificant dusting of fresh snow on all aspects above 600 metres initially, rising through the day as the snow thaws. Some deeper accumulations will remain on steep sheltered slopes on North to North-East aspects mainly above 700 metres. The old snow patches will be firm and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After some overnight light rain, with snow above 600 metres, it will be a generally dry and cloudy day, brightening and clearing later. The light South-West wind will back South-East and the freezing level will rise from 600 to 800 metres by the end of the period.
