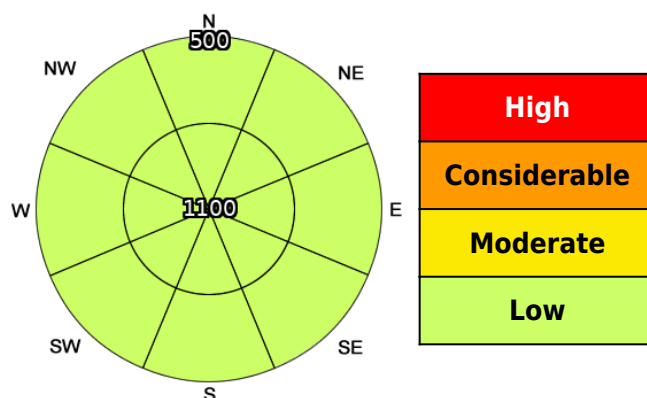
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A thin covering of fresh snow will be found on all aspects above 500 metres. Localised areas of fresh thin windslab will develop overnight mainly on North-East and East aspects above 800 metres. Accumulations are expected to be small. The older snowpack will remain frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow showers during the evening then generally dry. Moderate mainly South-Westerly winds becoming light during the day. Freezing level around 600 metres.

Comments

Sunday looks like a good day to get out before winds pick up and temperatures rise during Monday.
