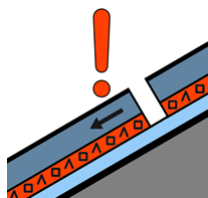

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 30/01/2017

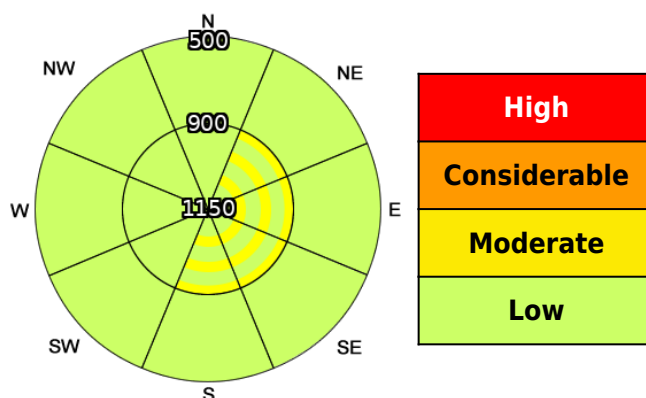
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will be found on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres where recent deposits overlie refrozen snow-ice. Drifts overlying bare ground will be present below this altitude. As the winds increase later in the period some limited drifting will occur onto West to North aspects. At present these slopes hold little snow and stability is not expected to be adversely affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day with the light South-South-Easterly winds increasing to strong by the end of the period. Temperature inversion persists with sub zero temperatures at 900 metres.
