



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 30/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing patchy snow pack which lies mainly on North to North-East aspects above 700 metres will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold conditions are forecast with a light South-East wind which will back East-South-East and gradually increase in strength to strong by the end of the period. Freezing levels will be around 450 metres rising abruptly to above summit levels by tomorrow evening.

Comments

Nice travel conditions in the glens with a picturesque dusting of fresh snow on the higher summits.
