

Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of fresh unstable windslab will be deposited mainly on North-West to Northerly aspects above 1000 metres. West and North-East aspects will also be affected by cross loaded deposits. At lower altitudes on these aspects the warmer temperature will cause a period of increased instability overnight followed by slow consolidation during the day. Aspects exposed to the wind will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-East wind easing during the day. Showers falling as snow only on the highest summits. A temperature inversion will clear to give a freezing level around summit levels.
