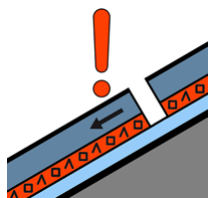

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to diminish in extent. The remaining snowpack which is confined to North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres will continue to consolidate, however some residual instabilities will remain in the snowpack but only in steep and convex terrain with corrie rims, gully exits and ridge crests affected. Elsewhere the ground will be mostly bare with the odd snow patch and snow drift. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mostly dry with the odd shower during the morning falling as sleet on the summits. Freezing level will be around summit levels. Winds will be generally light South to South-Easterly.
