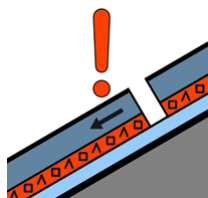
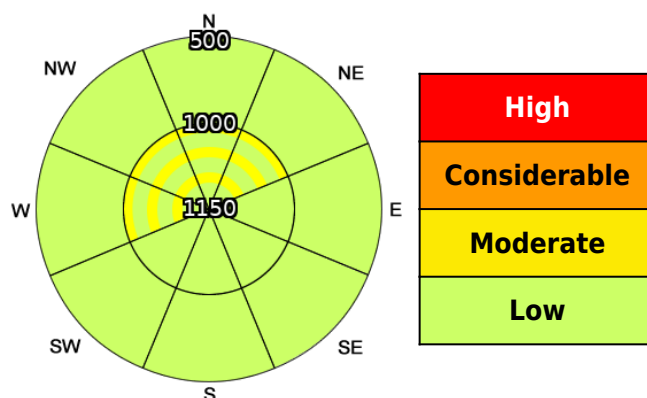


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 01/02/2017****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Though exhibiting wet surface layers the majority of the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. A few localised areas of moderately stable areas will be present in the deeper deposits that exist in steeper sheltered locations on West through North to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Although no significant precipitation has been forecast there may be some light rain at times. Moderate overnight winds will become strong Southerly by the end of the period. The freezing level will gradually lower from 1500 metres to reach 1000 metres by late afternoon.

Comments

Unsettled and often windy weather expected in the second half of the week as low pressure systems reach the UK.
