
#### Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining limited cover is in plateau areas and at the very top of sheltered North-West to North-East aspects above 900m, a few patches and ribbons run to 700m. The snowpack although moist, with localised surface wet snow instabilities will remain generally well bonded and stable; some rock and ice fall are possible below crags during thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Mild and wet with a slow steady thaw continuing. Freezing levels initially below summits to start the period will rise again to well above during the day. There will be a strong, Southerly airflow throughout.

#### Comments

Slow steady thaw conditions prevail.
