

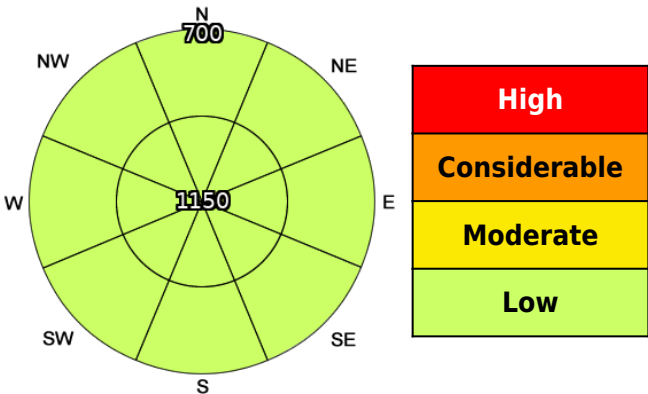

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 02/02/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing limited snowpack will continue to thaw and gradually consolidate. Quantities of fresh snow are expected to be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The light showers overnight may give some snow on the highest summits but will fall as rain at all levels through the day. The freezing level will be mainly above the summits. The wind will be strong to gale force from a generally South-Easterly direction.

Comments

Prospect of some snow on Friday and into the weekend with gale force Southerly winds.
