



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 03/02/2017**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Perhaps a light dusting of fresh snow overnight on the highest summits. Amounts will be insignificant. Otherwise, the very limited and patchy snowpack will remain firm and well bonded, becoming very firm above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a period of patchy rain pre-dawn, with possibly sleet and snow above 900 metres, it will be a mainly dry and cloudy day. The freezing level will lower to around 800 metres by mid morning and the gale force South-East wind overnight will gradually ease through the day, veering to become a fresh, generally Southerly.

**Comments**

The snow patches continue to thaw, but becoming colder tomorrow.
