

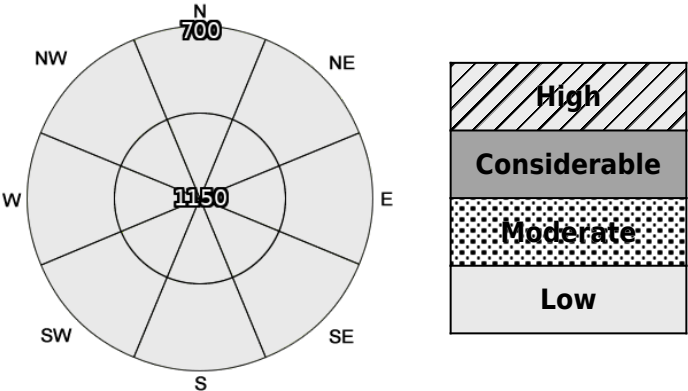

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight the existing snowpack will continue to thaw but remain generally stable. Amounts of fresh snow are not expected to be significant. Consolidation of the snowpack will continue through the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be steady light precipitation overnight which will bring some snow at the highest levels. It will be dry through the day. The freezing level will fall gradually overnight to around 800 metres through the day. The wind will ease through the period, South-Easterly veering Southerly.

Comments

Changeable weather on Saturday bringing some fresh snow with a fine day forecast for Sunday.
