



##### Avalanche Problems





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in wind-scoured areas and on ridges. Stability will decline steadily as the day progresses on sheltered North-West through North to East aspects as weakly-bonded windslab accumulates. Most affected areas will be steep gully exits and the top of coire headwalls above 900 metres where stability will be locally poor later. New cornice development expected over steepest lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Colder with a few overnight snow showers then more persistent snow from dawn onwards. Strong South-East winds, easing later and becoming South-Westerly.

##### Comments

Most snowfall expected from dawn onwards. Period of poorest stability expected to be later in the day.
