

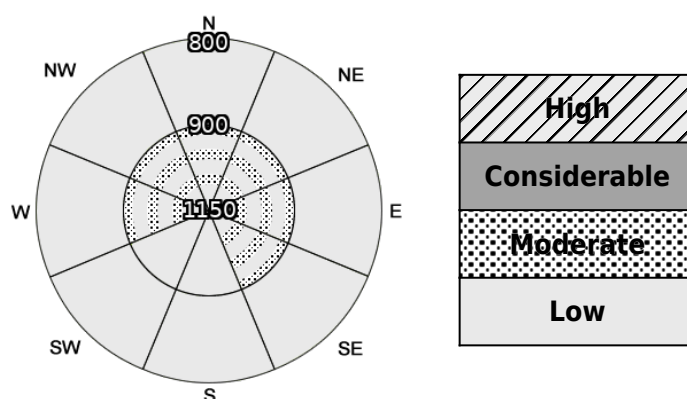

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 05/02/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a general covering of new snow on all aspects above 500 metres, lying mostly on bare ground. Some deeper localised accumulations will be present on steep sheltered North to North-East aspects above 650 metres, although amounts will not be significant. The remaining patches of old snow will be firm and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The rain and snow will peter out overnight to give a mainly dry and bright day with broken cloud. The strong South-West wind will gradually moderate throughout the period, backing South-East and the freezing level will fluctuate around 600 metres.

Comments

Fresh snowfall will continue into the night. Ridge of high pressure building tomorrow.
