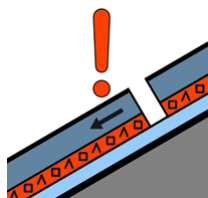
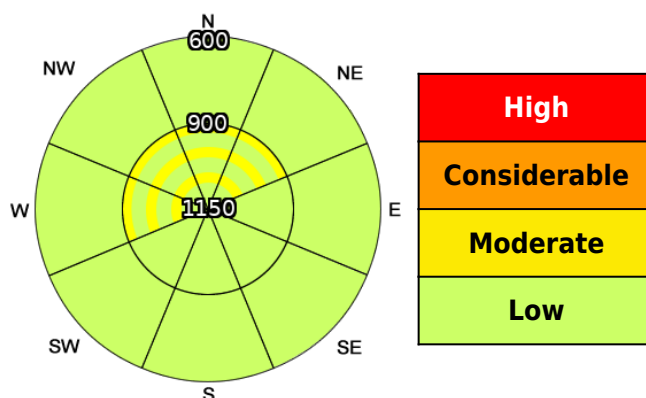


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 05/02/2017****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be a general thin covering of snow above 600 metres with localised deeper accumulations of unstable windslab present in sheltered locations on West through North to North-East aspects from 900 metres with features such as gully exits and steep corrie rims holding greatest amounts. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

With just a trace of new snow expected it will be mainly dry throughout the forecast period. The strong South-South-Westerly winds will back South-South-Easterly becoming light. It will remain cold with the freezing level at around 600 metres.
