

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Light snow showers this evening with drifting in the strengthening winds. Further windslab will develop on to North-West through North to East aspects above 700 metres. Additional snow showers later tomorrow afternoon will load more snow on to these poorly bonded accumulations which will become weaker. Cornices will continue to build. South-East through South to West aspects will become scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

An occluded front will bring a band of light snow to the area. At first moderate winds will be South - South - Easterly backing Southerly and strengthening to gale force. The freezing level will hover around 600 metres.
