




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the early evening and overnight wind transported snow will continue to build unstable and isolated areas of poorly bonded windslab on to wind sheltered West through North to East aspects above 700 metres. Also on these aspects cornices will continue to build. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

At first gale force winds will be South-East, easing by early morning becoming variable moderate South - Westerly. Freezing level will rise slightly from around 400 metres to 700 meters. Moderate intermittent snow showers are expected.

Comments

A nice enough winters day in the glens but it felt very cold and serious higher up in the Northerly corries of Liathach today.
