

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 12/02/2017


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected. The general snow cover will remain thin and stable. Minor weaknesses will persist in the snowpack where pockets of snow gain depth and extent, mostly above 800 metres, and mainly on North-West, through North to East facing ridge flanks and gully exits. Other aspects and some summit slopes will remain bare. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold and dry, with broken cloud drifting in from the East. A moderate Easterly wind will freshen through the day and the main freezing level will be well below the summits.

Comments

Hard frozen ground. Good walking conditions. High windchill at summit levels.
