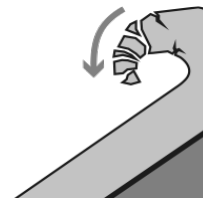

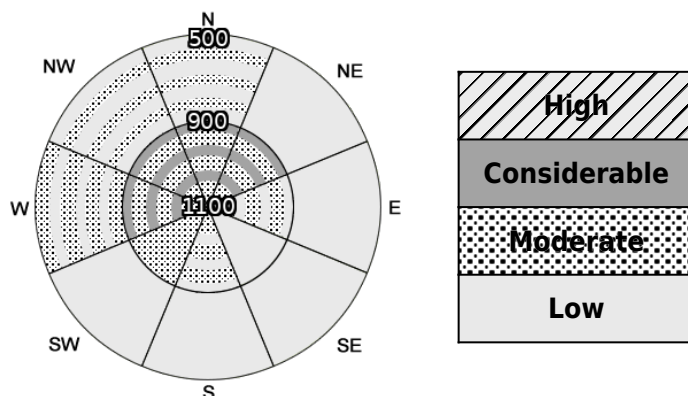

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional new weak windslab build up is expected on steepest South-West to West aspects above 900 metres. Lingering localised instability on North-West to North-East aspects. Most affected areas will be the top of coire backwalls and gully exits above 900 metres. Pockets of poorly stabilised snow will also be present on the flanks of selected East-facing gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow flurries are possible, otherwise dry and cold with a strong Easterly airflow.
